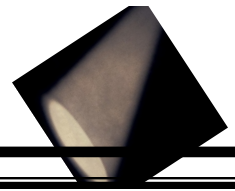

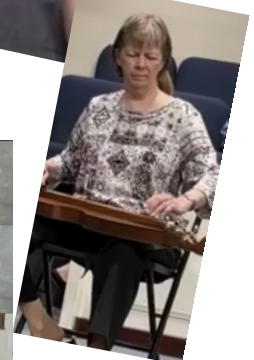
Music Notes

Adults on Mission

MAY News

The Adults on Mission Craft Ministry resumed two weeks ago, and we have been so excited to be back together again to fellowship with one another, and pick up with ongoing, and new creations. At our first gathering, we shared how we saw the Lord care for us, individually, during the Pandemic in happy, sad and trying times. It was a sweet time of sharing and offering praise to the Father.

Because we worked from home, we were not even aware of our total group accomplishments during the Pandemic, and after the report, we all agreed that the Lord continually opened doors for our crafts, and most importantly, the sharing of His Love and Word, even in the midst of a shut-down. We now share with you.

- April 2020 60 Treat Boxes and Scripture Cards were delivered to *Ansley Park Nursing and Rehab Center* in Newnan. Our efforts brightened the day of the residents to know they were being thought of at a time when they could not have any contact from the outside.
- July 2020 We shipped 100 Bears, 25 Hats for babies and preemies, 167 Scripture Crosses, and 5 Book Bags to *God's Love from a Diaper Bag* to our Appalachian neighbors in Jenkins, Kentucky.
- August 2020 70 Bears, Scripture Crosses and Treat Boxes were delivered to *Baptist Manor* in Palmetto. The residents expressed appreciation for our thoughtfulness as they were confined to their rooms for some very long days.
- Sept. 2020 Items shipped to *God's Love from a Diaper Bag* included 200 Scripture Crosses, 29 Hats for babies and preemies, 51 Bracelets, 25 Chick-fil-A Games and Coloring Books, 36 Handmade Baby Washcloths, and 2 Book Bags.
- Oct. 2020 *God's Love from a Diaper Bag*, shipped 50 Baby Washcloths, and 40 Bears.
- Dec. 2020 *God's Love from a Diaper Bag*, 163 Bracelets, 22 Pillowcase Dresses, 103 Baby Washcloths, 100 Scripture Crosses, 77 Bears, 17 Book Bags. This shipment was hand delivered to Kentucky for us. In addition to our items, we sent 35 Baby Blankets, and 50 Hats for babies and preemies, given to us from an individual not affiliated with SBC.
- Feb. 2021 61 Baby Washcloths and Bears were shipped to *God's Love from a Diaper Bag*.
- March 2021 60 Easter Treat Boxes and 60 Crocheted Easter Rabbits with Scripture were delivered to *Ansley Park Rehab Center* in Newnan.
- April 2021 Delivered 40 Bottles of Dawn Dish Detergent wrapped in a Dishcloth and Scripture Card to the I-58 Mission in Senoia. The folks were thrilled because dish detergent is an item not usually available at a food pantry. Frank DeLoach made the delivery, and was asked if we could create eye glass holders, which we are now working on for our next project.
- Also in April, we delivered 51 Handmade Burp Pads to the *Coweta Pregnancy Services* in Newnan.

Olive Branch paid for 1,000 mailers that went out to many houses in the Sharpsburg area. If it brought in one for our Easter events, it's worth that postage. Jesus said, "..... go after the ONE that was lost....." when he told the parable in Luke about the 100 sheep minus the one that was wandering lost. The next mailer Olive Branch is providing the postage on is for VBS. Let's be praying ahead of time that those will not only reach physical mailboxes, but the hearts and heads of those recipients and that VBS this summer will be overflowing!!

Our handmade crafts for the Country Western themed BBQ in March netted \$600 for the mortgage payment. There was more money made than that with the food, but the crafts were donated by our members.

We made a donation to Pastor Doug McCart and his wife, Greta, of Unity Baptist Church in Newnan to assist them with their recovery. You may recall their story of the loss of their home (RV) and all their personal belongings from local news coverage following the EF-4 tornado of March 26th.

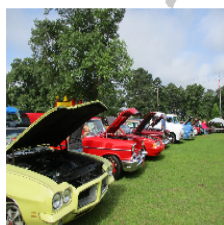
