One bright Sunday morning in June, as we're all getting ready for Sunday school and church, Ken Hayes is showing concern of the sanctuary's overhead projector. You know, the one that projects the words of hymns, pictures, videos, and sermon notes. After a closer observation, Ken and I look at each other and conclude that our 20+ year old projector bulb has seen its last day. We sorrowfully look at each other- "Oh well . . . looks like we're going old school today!"

Yes-- all the texts, all the pictures, and all the sermon notes that Cheri O'Neal so carefully prepared for the day's church service, had gone for naught. As it turned out, we went "old school" for a couple of weeks searching for the out-of-date projector bulb, for the out-of-date projector. We put it in the hands of our most talented "video master" Allen Nolan to determine the next steps we should take. I was reminded of a song our choir sang not too long ago—"Blessings"—that tells us that sometimes what we think is going to affect us in a negative way may actually be "mercies in disguise." From light bulbs to pandemics, we still need to trust in God, and He will see us through.
